Day 2 — Delhi → Mathura → Vrindavan

Drive to Krishna's birthplace. Lathmar Holi in Barsana — women playfully beat men with sticks. Evening flower aarti at Banke Bihari.

Stay: Boutique Vrindavan hotel | **Meals:** Breakfast | **Transfer:** AC sedan | **Distance:** Delhi → Mathura · 180 km · 3.5 hrs

Day 3 — Vrindavan → Agra — Holi Day

Morning flower Holi at Banke Bihari Temple. Drive to Agra. Afternoon private color Holi at a heritage haveli (organic gulal, music, dance, traditional bhang lassi — adult option).

Stay: 5★ Agra hotel | **Meals:** Breakfast, festive lunch | **Transfer:** AC sedan | **Distance:** Vrindavan → Agra · 70 km · 1.5 hrs

Day 4 — Agra → Jaipur — Elephant Festival

Sunrise Taj Mahal, drive to Jaipur. Afternoon Elephant Festival at Chaugan Stadium (decorated elephants, polo, beauty contest).

Stay: 5★ Jaipur hotel | **Meals:** Breakfast | **Transfer:** AC sedan | **Distance:** Agra → Jaipur · 240 km · 5 hrs

Day 5 — Jaipur → Delhi · Departure

Morning Amber Fort + city, drive to Delhi.
